Colder weather!


This week, has seen the weather become much colder and more seasonally normal.

End of term assessments

We completed different end of term assessments recently and I intend for these to take place every term moving forward. These inform teachers' judgements about the amount of learning the children have retained and this informs teachers' planning of future lessons and enables them to identify gaps in learning. Also, it enables children to start developing test techniques and practice as they move through the school.



The assessments are from a highly regarded company that works closely with the DfE so they are in line with SATs expectations and they provided teachers with standardised scores (like the SATs tests.)

This first round of assessments went extremely well and staff have found the results informative.
