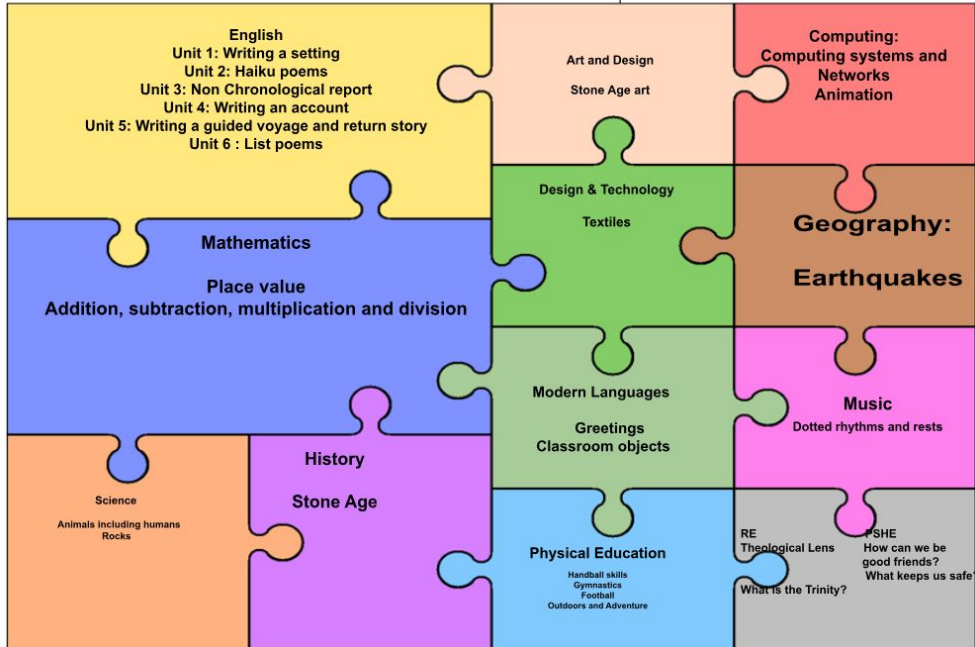

School Uniform

We want to encourage learning to take place outside as often as possible. Therefore, we are asking that all children are supplied with wellington boots, waterproof jackets and waterproof over trousers so we are not restricted by the weather. We use Class Dojo. This app is free (please do not sign up for a subscription). Parents are able to contact the class teacher, SLT and the ELSA using the messaging app on this.

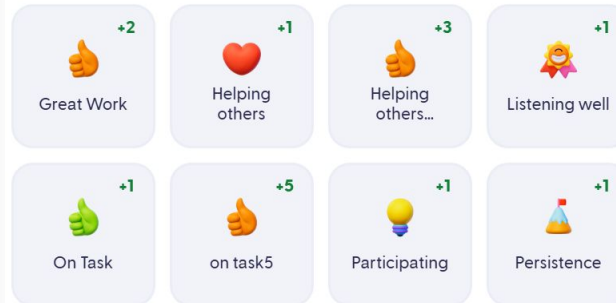
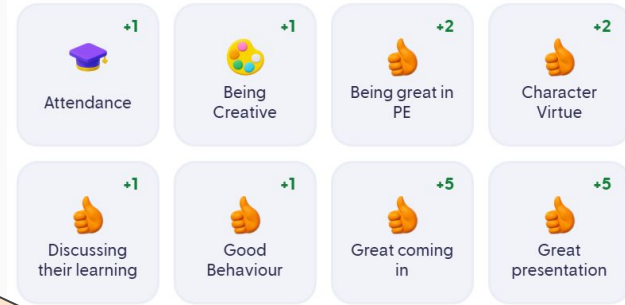


You will receive an invite to sign up on 1st/2nd September. This will be sent via an email.
