



Doggy Dos and Don'ts



DO

- Always approach Woody calmly and slowly; preferably standing up and from the front
- Always be gentle with Woody
- Let Woody come to you
- All interactions must remain calm with the authorised adult in control at all times
- Children must wash/sanitise their hands after they have stroked Woody

DON'T

- Never run up to Woody
- Don't hold out your hand - stand still and watch Woody's body language
- Do not put your face near Woody's
- Do not disturb Woody when he is eating or sleeping
- Do not feed Woody bits of your own food
