Interpreting progress scores:

Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

- A score of 0 means pupils in this school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive (+) score means pupils in this school on average do better at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally
- A negative (-) score means pupils in this school on average do worse at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points from KS1.
